The Buhl Police Department will continue full operations and services to the community with a few minor modifications to our daily operations. Our goal is to continue providing services to our community in a way that will reduce exposure of the COVID-19 Virus to community members and our staff as well. It is essential at this time that we stay attentive and work together in addressing the Coronavirus and reducing the spread of the virus.

Response to calls for service

- Officers/Employees will be handling calls VIA landline when it's possible to handle such incident over the phone.
- When needed our employees will use all the proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
 - Wear eye protection that wraps around for better protection.
 - Wear disposable gloves when in contact with public
 - Wear mask if the situation calls for one.
- Buhl Police Department will be dialing back our response to med calls. Fire and Medical personnel will be responding to medical calls first. If Law Enforcement is needed Fire and EMS will advise and an officer will respond.
- **Our work area**
 - Visitors to our offices are asked to communicate through the sliding window.
 - Employees are making sure we are wiping down their work area/equipment/vehicles/office counter/doors etc. to help prevent the spread of the virus.
- **City Services currently affected:**
 - City services are currently open at this time. However, the police station will be limiting access to an as needed basis.
 - All tours of the police department are suspended at this time.
 - Ride along program(s) are suspended at this time.
 - The records dept. has suspended finger printing citizens.
