IMPORTANT REMINDERS

 - State their name, and whether they are a resident or property owner of the City of Buhl
- All public input will be limited to THREE (3) minutes at the discretion of the mayor.
 - Individuals are not permitted to give their time to other speakers.
- This is not a question-and-answer period with Council.
- All presenters shall remain respectful.
- Public input will NOT be about personnel, personnel-related issues or any of the items that were on this agenda (as these were not public hearing related topics). If an item is NOT on the agenda, public input will be allowed on the topic.
 - Any and all issues involving City personnel should be directly communicated with the mayor, not addressed during citizen comments.

Anyone failing to follow these rules will be provided with one (1) warning. Should the speaker continue to disregard these rules after the warning, they will be asked to return to their seat.
