REGULAR SESSION called to order at 7:00 PM.

CONFIRMATION OF QUORUM:

Karen Drown confirmed a quorum.

OLD BUSINESS:

- ... Minutes of February 22, 2016: Michael Higbee moved to approve the minutes; Kyle Hauser seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the motion passed.
- ... Monthly Claims for Payment: Kyle Hauser moved to approve the monthly claims for payment; Sue Gabardi seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the motion passed.
- ... Monthly Reports: Michael Higbee moved to approve the monthly department head reports; Kyle Hauser seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the motion passed.
- ... Clerk/Treasurer Report: Sue Gabardi moved to approve the clerk/treasurer report; Kyle Hauser seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the motion passed.
- ... Monthly Report: Mayor McCauley updated council on the Engineers Report. The Urban Renewal Agency and also Planning and Zoning would be meeting that week. Building permit applications are up from the previous year. The GIS system has been started with software installed and training to come later in March. He also added the ICDBG application addendum had been accepted and we should know by the end of April if the Urban Renewal Agency received the grant.

NEW BUSINESS:

Consideration of 5K Color Run: Danielle Chavez and Mauri Gowans explained to Council they co-advise the Multicultural Club at the high school and this 5K would be one of their fundraisers to help send a group of students to Europe. They explained the 7th Street Gym would provide the

bathroom facilities for the event and the race would start from there and work its way through residential areas and end back at Eastman Park. There would be color stations setup at certain areas in the race and they would have at least one adult at each station. They added the color is made up of food grade cornstarch and cosmetic dyes and it does not stain anything. They detailed their plan for notifying the residents in the area with flyers. They added the race would be from 10 am to 12 pm and it has been set to cape at 200 runners. Insurance would fall under the school district because no major highways are being crossed and when it does cross Sawtooth Ave and Main Street there will be crossing guards. Kyle moved to approve the Buhl 5K Color Run on April 2, 2016. Sue seconded the motion. There was no further discussion and the motion passed.

COUNCIL CONCERNS – Kyle asked if there was something to do for Pam while she was down.

Michael commented two candidates for the firefighter/EMT positions had been selected and both have accepted the conditional terms. He added both our local kids who have the right attitudes about volunteers.
