- No more than two "Project" cars also on the East side of building

- Property must be kept clear of vehicle parts, unnecessary equipment and debris.

Mr. Tews spoke in favor of S & L repair, stating that he understands the need for an orderly property but that Mr. Belt is trying to do a good job and the only guy that works on tractors on the West end of the county.

PUBLIC HEARING #2 was opened: Rex Harding, a Design Engineer, spoke on behalf of Debra Gibson to inform commission on the preliminary and final plats request for approval for Homestead Subdivision #3.

The only concern was the road issue in Homestead Subdivision Number 2. The City has a written agreement from Ms. Gibson stating that the road will be repaired to the City's satisfaction even if it means taking all the asphalt out and replacing it. This hearing was closed at 11:02 am.
