- No more than two "Project" cars and they must be parked on the east side of the building
- Business hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm
- Not open on Sunday
- Property must be kept clear of vehicle parts, unnecessary equipment and debris
- Maximum of 10 total vehicles, excluding employee and owner's vehicles, outside of the building
- No vehicles will be advertised for sale
- After 30 days delinquent vehicles must be moved to an off-site impound yard
